## Class Work

### Introduction

#### Comparing Numbers

While comparing two numbers, one number is the same as, or smaller than, or bigger than, another number.

Eg:- Cost of a motor bike is ₹ 55,000 and Cost of a Car is ₹ 2,58,000. Compare and answer which is costlier.

Solution The number with greater number of digits is the greater number. Therefore,  $55,000 < 2,58,000$   
So, the Car is Costlier.

Eg:- Compare 8 and 12.

Solution :-  $8 < 12$
